

01

Mon

Arrive in Japan Narita International Airport (NRT) and meet your host at the airport. Travel by private car to a peaceful farmhouse in Chiba. Settle in, join a short onboarding session, and enjoy a delicious supper made with local ingredients.

Rest and relax, your journey starts here.

02

Tue

Start your day on the farm.

Meet the local farmers and take part in seasonal activities, from planting to harvesting. Enjoy a hearty, home-cooked farm lunch.

Enjoy dinner at a local restaurant or take a peaceful bike ride through the countryside.

03

Wed

Whether it's planting or september harvest, each season brings its own unique rhythm. Depending on the time of year, you may also have the chance to visit another local farm, learn about matcha, peanuts, miso paste, sake, May rice planting and more. Lunch is provided. Ask your host about seasonal events and optional farm visits.

04

Thurs

Tokyo. Arrive in the city and settle in. Take part in a traditional tea ceremony or similar activity.

Optional Visit Shibuya Sky, Teamlabs or pick something from our optional activities. We can help you book your tickets!

05

Fri

Start your morning with a visit to the famous Tsukiji Tokyo fish market. Attend a Japanese tea ceremony. Learn the art of shaping perfect bite-sized sushi; our sushi chef will demonstrate how to make Edomae sushi or experience a traditional Japanese dance lesson and a Kimono fitting.

06

Sat

Join your host at a Tokyo Community event, where locals gather to learn new English skills. Your role? Chat, share, and connect, offering light language support and cultural exchange. A lovely way to experience Tokyo's heart, through its people.




